Supports and Resources

Fall Semester

- Jefferson Jr/Sr High counseling staff present support resources to seniors
- Seniors apply to enter the College Jumpstart program
- Counseling staff will find the student who are track to graduate and need extra support to college

Spring Semester

- Counseling staff will work with student to discover which track is best for each student
- Counseling staff will work with partners to find individualized support resources like scholarships, jobs, shadowing opportunities
- Counseling staff will work with teachers and other staff to make sure students follow through on school work necessary to graduate
- Mock interview prep (1/25), mock interviews (2/1-2/2) and job fair on (5/3)
- Seniors will be paired with a mentor if they are enrolled in Goodwill's CareerPlus program

College Transition in the Fall

- Red Rocks student mentors will follow up with College Jumpstart students just before fall semester starts to help with transition
- Students who enroll at other colleges will be paired with oncampus support organizations

Incentives

- Students who enroll in college and attend the first three weeks of college will receive a computer, Microsoft Office and a printer
- Students will receive a Beyond Jeffco scholarship (COSI)
- Students will be paired with a job that encourages their educational goals

Summer

- Graduates will be enrolled in College Jumpstart program with Red Rocks
- Students will be paired with a Red Rocks student mentor
- Students will receive assistance in enrolling in Red Rocks or another school if they haven't already
